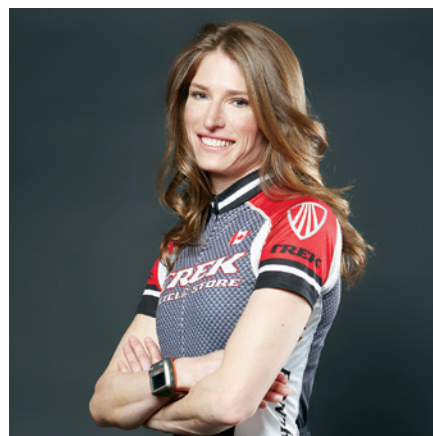


Ayesha Rollinson
